

WHAT TO DO IF YOU'RE INVOLVED IN A HIGHWAY ACCIDENT

1 Assess the situation

Are there any injuries? Are vehicles drivable? Are drugs or alcohol involved? Do not leave the scene.

2 Move your car to a safe place

If your car is drivable, move it to the shoulder, an emergency pullout or off-ramp shoulder.

3 Call 911

Notify the 911 operator of your accident and location.

4 Exchange information

Get the following information from others involved in the accident: name, address, phone number, vehicle make, model, year, color, insurance carrier and policy number.

5 Report the accident

Report the accident as required by law enforcement and your insurance provider.
